Precautionary Phrases

SECTION 4: First-aid measures

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4.1 **Description of First Aid Measures:**

Eye	Flush victim's eyes with water, while holding the eyelids apart. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing. Get medical attention if irritation persists.		
Skin Inhalation	None normally required. For excessive unintentional exposures, wash skin with water. Remove to fresh air. Get medical attention if irritation or symptoms occur.		

Ingestion If small quantities are swallowed, rinse out mouth with water. Do not induce vomiting unless directed to by a doctor or physician. Get medical attention for large ingestions.

4.2 Most Important Symptoms and Effects, Both Acute and Delayed:

Causes eye irritation. May be mildly irritating to skin, and upper respiratory tract. Ingestion may result in nervous system effects including headache, sleepiness, dizziness, slurred speech, and blurred vision.

Immediate medical attention should not be required.

SECTION 5: Fire-fighting measures

5.1 Suitable and Unsuitable Extinguishing Media:

Use water spray, fog or mist, alcohol foam, or dry chemicals to extinguish.

Special Hazards Arising from the Substance or Mixture: 5.2

Flammable liquid and vapor. This product is classified as a flammable liquid and vapor but will not sustain combustion. Vapors may accumulate in confined areas and present a fire or explosion hazard. Vapors may be heavier than air and travel along surfaces to remote ignition sources and flash back. Exposure to high temperatures may release flammable hydrocarbons that can accumulate in confined areas and present a fire or explosion hazard. Burning may release hydrocarbons, and oxides of carbon.

5.3 Advice for Fire-Fighters:

Firefighters should wear full emergency equipment and approved positive pressure self-contained breathing apparatus for all fires involving chemicals.

SECTION 6: Accidental release measures

6.1. Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures

Avoid breathing vapors, or mist. Ventilate the area, Remove all sources of ignition. Wear appropriate personal protective equipment as specified in Section 8. Keep unnecessary personnel away

6.2. Environmental precautions

Do not flush large quantities into surface water or sanitary sewer system. Prevent large quantities of product from entering drains. For smaller quantities, drench with water making sure washings enter drain only when very dilute.

6.3 Methods and Material for Containment and Cleaning up:

Stop spill at source if safe to do so. Contain spill and pump liquid into a suitable container or absorb with an inert absorbent and place in a suitable container. Clean spill area with water.

SECTION 7: Handling and storage

Precautions for safe handling 7.1.

Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Use with adequate ventilation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors and mists. Wash exposed skin thoroughly with soap and water after use. Wear appropriate personal protective equipment as specified in Section 8. Observe good industrial hygiene practices.

7.2. Conditions for safe storage, including any incompatibilities

Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Keep container tightly closed. Store away from oxidizing agents and other incompatible materials. Keep away from open flames, sparks, and excessive heat. Store in containers made of stainless steel, HDPE, PET, or glass. Do not store in contact with Iron, Aluminum, Zinc, Copper or their alloys since Witch Hazel is particularly reactive with Iron. Product will discolor if it comes in contact with Iron.
